Element 1- Take action prior to and during a nav. emergency

- Engage in a fire and survival drill.
- Practice MOB drill.
- Determining simulated rescue locations from task information.
- Devising a simulated search plan with LKP and probable position after delay.

Element 2- Perform damage control measures after a navigational emergency

- Studying Squad SOP’s and Emergency Safety Management plans.
- Audit of emergency equipment.
- Practice of emergency procedures.

Element 3- Manage the abandonment of the vessel

- Practice of emergency procedures.

Element 4- Re-float a grounded vessel

- Practice damage control for watertight integrity.

Element 5- Coordinate emergency towing operations

- Practice towing a simulated marine casualty.
