WITNESS STATEMENT COMPLETION INSTRUCTIONS

PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING NOTES CAREFULLY BEFORE COMMENCING YOUR STATEMENT

- → Provide lead up information of events that occurred prior to the actual incident. For example: Where you boarded the vessel and with whom.
- → Include a description of the weather, visibility and sea (water) conditions.
- → Provide as much detail as possible about the actual incident including distance from objects, time and speed estimates.
- → Write only about what YOU saw and heard.
- → Conversation should be in the first person. For example:

I said, "....."

He said, "...."

- → If you are unable to recall first person conversation you may still record the conversation to the best of your recollection.
- → Include any boating qualifications and experience you may have.
